Online Communication

Leaving Appropriate Comments

Materials

- Printed worksheets
- Something to write with

Instructions:

- Tell students: ***“We are going to talk about what makes an online comment appropriate or inappropriate. Appropriate comments are positive, encouraging, or inquisitive remarks that show interest and respect for the other person's post. Inappropriate comments are negative, rude, or dismissive remarks that can hurt the other person's feelings.”***
- Distribute differentiated worksheets according to student needs.
- Tell students: ***Look at the example social media post and write or identify an appropriate comment to leave under the image.***
- Tell students ***“You will earn participation dollar for every comment you write/identify. Once you have identified your answer, I’ll ask someone to share more about their answer. Adding to your answer can earn you more participation dollars.”***

Differentiated Instruction:

- **Tier 1:** Students will write an appropriate comment beneath each example social media post on their worksheets.
- **Tier 2:** Students will identify the appropriate comment left beneath each example social media post on their worksheets.
- **Tier 3:** Students will circle a thumbs up or thumbs down to show if the comment left beneath the example social media post is appropriate or inappropriate.

Incorporate Bankability:

- Students will answer questions during the activity and earn Bankability dollars for following directions, participating, and remaining on-task.
- Teachers will enter dollar amounts to the students’ Bankability accounts.

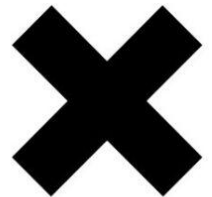
