

## UNIT 6: CONNECTING ON THE INTERNET LESSON 9: CONNECTING WITH BLOGS

### LESSON OVERVIEW

Use this lesson plan to help guide the facilitation of Digitability’s Unit 6-Lesson 9. This lesson plan will help you take the learning offline and into the whole classroom, where collaborative learning, direct instruction, and guided practice will help your students reach their goal of achieving digital literacy.

**Time:** ~25 minutes

### OBJECTIVE

Student is able to describe methods for communicating online.

## LESSON PLAN

### WARM UP

1. Write the definition of the Like Button on the board leaving a blank space for the word networks.

The Like Button: a button found on social \_\_\_\_ used to like posts on the Internet.

2. Have a student come up to the board to fill in the correct answer.
3. Ask, *“For a participation dollar, raise your hand if you know what a blog is.”*

4. Give immediate feedback and record Workplace Behavior earnings on the Dollar Earnings Tracker. [6.9.DollarTracker]

*“Marcus writes down the word networks on the board. Nice job participating and earning a dollar Marcus. Who else would like to share for a participation dollar.”*



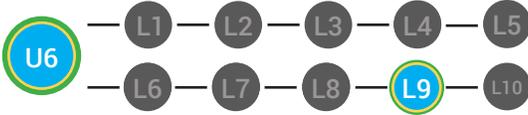

### DIFFERENTIATION

**Award at least four participation dollars.**

- T1** Writes response on the board
- T2** Writes response on the board with assistance from a Tier 1 partner
- T3** Writes response on the board with assistance from an adult or points to **Yes or No Image Exchange Card** [6.IEC.Y/N] for rephrased question.



## GUIDED WATCHING

 1. Ask, *“For a participation dollar, who can tell me the name of our next badge?”*

**Answer:** Connecting With Blogs

2. Give immediate feedback and record Workplace Behavior earnings on the Dollar Earnings Tracker. [6.9.DollarTracker]

  
*“Marcus answers Connecting With Blogs. Nice job participating and earning a dollar Marcus. Who else would like to share for a participation dollar.”*

 Use supplemental material Badge Board **6.BADGE**. See  **DIFFERENTIATION** below to identify supplements needed for your students.

### DIFFERENTIATION

**Award at least four participation dollars.**

**T1** Correct Verbal Response.

**T2** Writes down badge name using **Badge Board** [6.BADGE] for this unit.

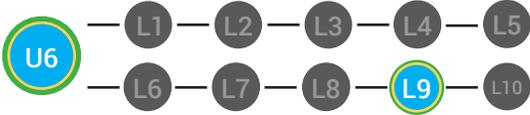
**T3** Uses **Badge Board** [6.BADGE] for this unit.

 3. Bring attention to screen, *“Let’s watch this lesson. I know that [student’s name] is actively watching because he has his eyes on the screen and he is actively listening by giving a thumbs up when he hears the words Connecting With Blogs.”*

4. Ask students to give a thumbs up every time they hear and/or see the words Connecting With Blogs in the video. Distribute **Thumbs Image Exchange cards** [6.9.THUMB]

 5. Play video.

-- Video Ends (Do not click Activity Button yet) --



6. Give immediate feedback and record Workplace Behavior earnings on the Dollar Earnings Tracker. [6.9.DollarTracker]



"I see students putting there thumbs up and pointing to thumb cards. Nice Job!"

Award at least four participation dollars.



## DIFFERENTIATION



T1 Verbal response with examples of experience



T2 Verbal response or holds up **Thumbs Image Exchange cards** [6.9.THUMB] for potential vocabulary word or icon



T3 Holds up or points to **Thumbs Image Exchange cards** [6.9.THUMB] to hold up or point to potential vocabulary word or icon

## INFORMAL ASSESSMENT (AFTER PLAYING VIDEO)



1. Ask, *"For a participation dollar, who can tell me what a blog is?"*  
Write the term and definition in notebooks after student responses.
2. Ask, *"For a participation dollar, do blogs only have text?"*
3. Ask, *"For a participation dollar, is a blogger someone who writes new content for a blog?"*
4. Ask, *"For a participation dollar, can other people like my posts?"*



Structure prompting to get students to come up with a definition using language from the video.

**EXAMPLE:** "A blog is a website that lets you write about the things that are interesting to you."

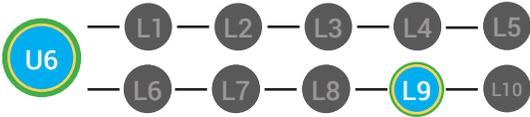
5. Give immediate feedback and record Workplace Behavior earnings on the Dollar Earnings Tracker. [6.9.DollarTracker]



"Marcus answers yes. Nice job participating and earning a dollar Marcus. Who else would like to share for a participation dollar."



Use supplemental material YES/NO Image Exchange cards 6.IEC.Y/N to students. See DIFFERENTIATION below to identify supplements needed for your students.



## DIFFERENTIATION

Award at least four participation dollars.

- T1** Verbal response with examples of experience
- T2** Verbal response or holds up **YES/NO Image Exchange cards** [6.IEC.Y/N] for a rephrased question.
- T3** Holds up or points to **YES/NO Image Exchange cards** [6.IEC.Y/N] for a rephrased question.

## PLAY ACTIVITY VIDEO



1. Ask the class, “Who would like to unlock the Connecting With Blogs Badge for \$1?”

2. Give immediate feedback and record Workplace Behavior earnings on the Dollar Earnings Tracker. [6.9.DollarTracker]

**Click Activity Button to Play Activity Video**

3. Student discusses with class to choose the correct answer.
- a. If student chooses correct answer, have student or whole class dance.
  - b. If student chooses incorrect answer, repeat Step 2 until student unlocks the badge.



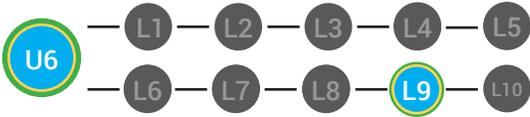
“Marcus unlocks the Connecting With Blogs badge. Nice job participating and earning a dollar Marcus.”



Increase the dollar amount for shy students or to increase motivation.



Use supplemental material Lesson Badge Cut Out **6.9.6** Students that unlocked the badge will place the print out on the classroom’s **word wall**. See DIFFERENTIATION below to identify supplements needed for your students.



## DIFFERENTIATION

- T1** Student will use verbal prompting to unlock the badge with the class.
- T2** Student will use verbal prompting and hand signals to unlock the badge with the class
- T3** Student will use hand signals, pointing, prompting levels or adult/Tier 1 partner support to unlock the badge with the class.

## ASSESSMENT/EXIT SLIP

1. Students will complete the Connecting With Blogs Exit Slip.
2. Students will staple the worksheet into their notebook or put in their folder.

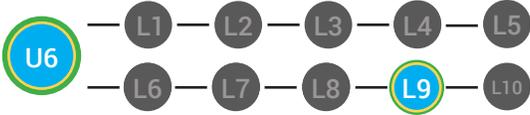

- T3** Student's complete **Trace 'n' Learn card** [6.9.7.2]



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## IMMEDIATE FEEDBACK/NEXT STEPS

1. Read off Dollar Earnings Tracker and announce how many dollars each student earned during the lesson.
2. Students will fill in their dollar earnings from the lesson using their [My Digitability Earnings sheet [6.9.8] Have students staple this sheet into their notebooks so they can use it for the entire unit.
3. Ask students what they will do with their money. Spend it or save it?
4. If time permits, you can either have students log into their student accounts for independent practice or continue on to the next lesson plan.
